- 2. Puglia, **the heel of Italy's boot**, is a **sun-baked region** that has a rich culture of simple pleasures.
- 3. Puglia **boasts** gorgeous beaches, **lush** farmland, ornate churches, and ancient ruins. It's also **home to** many of the foods Italy is famous for!
- 4. Puglia, the region in the **heel of Italy's boot**, is **dotted** with beautiful small towns **in shades of white** and gold.
- 5. Puglia the "**spur**" and "**hee**l" of the Italian boot is one of Europe's great agricultural areas, its immense plains and **rolling hills** producing much of Italy's wine and olive oil, vast quantities of its fruit and vegetables, and most of the hard durum wheat used to make its pasta.
